

Worplesdon Rangers FC Player Bursary Policy

About The Player Bursary Policy

At the start of each season, the Club will set aside a sum of money (to be decided annually at the first Committee Meeting of the season) to provide training for **current** Club players to undertake one of the following courses, in order to advance their career in football:

- FA Level 1 Coaching
- ❖ FA Referees Course (9v9 / 11v11 football only)
- ❖ FA Mini Soccer Referees Course (Under 7 Under 10)

Eligibility

Current players that are interested in applying for a Club bursary should complete the attached form and send it to the Club Secretary to register their interest, between 1 September and 31 October annually.

Should an applicant have any outstanding registration, fines or match fees etc. they will automatically be excluded from this Bursary opportunity, until the outstanding sum is settled in full.

If demand exceeds available funds, a draw will be organised at the November committee meeting, with successful applicants being drawn by the Chairman.

Terms

Successful applicants will be expected to offer their services to Worplesdon Rangers FC in the first instance, for a 12-month period following completion of their chosen course.

Successful applicants are required to book and pay for their own course. Once the course is successfully completed, a copy of their certificate should be sent to the Club Secretary, who will arrange for their course fees to be reimbursed either by cheque or bank transfer.

The committee reserves the right to withdraw Bursary funding in any season where Club funds do not allow for it.
